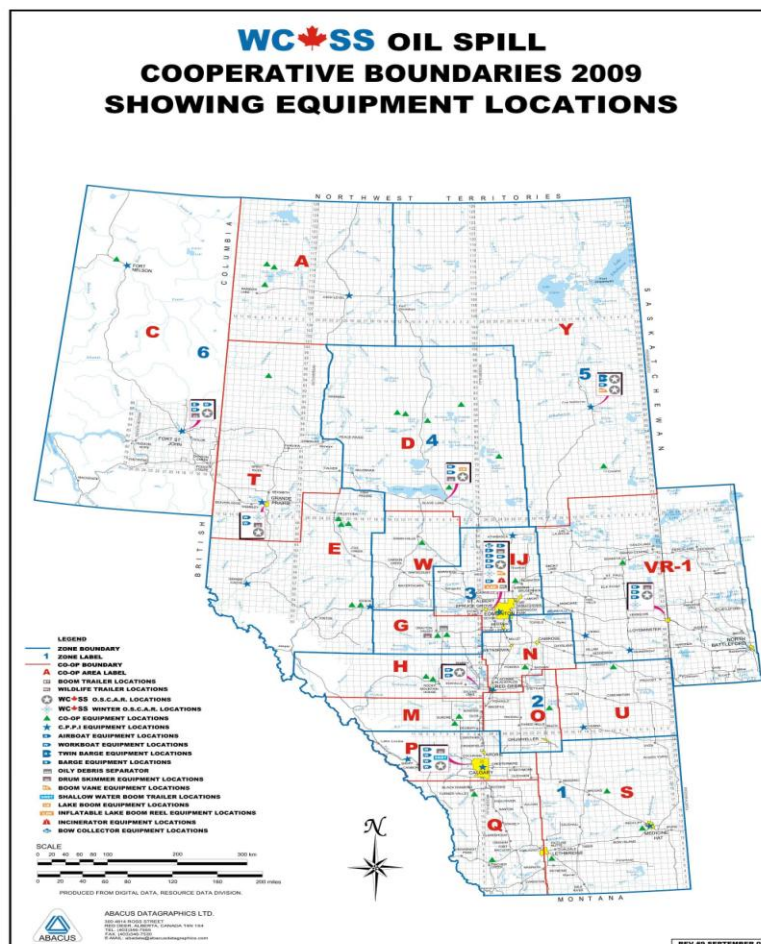

The company requesting the equipment is responsible for transportation costs and any consumable products used. An equipment usage agreement must be signed.

Each member company requiring the use of the Area “C” equipment is responsible to ensure that the unit is returned to its designated storage location as soon as possible after containment and recovery operations are completed.

The company last using the units shall notify the Chairman/Alternate Chairman advising him that the units has been returned to its normal storage location. A joint inspection of the units will then be made by the company involved and the Area “C” Equipment Supervisor. The Chairman will immediately arrange to have the units cleaned and all equipment inventory and materials checked, either repaired or replaced as deemed necessary. All costs will be charged directly to the Company having used the equipment.
